PROFILE

Mr. Moy is a Senior Associate with the Federal Practice Group. His practice is focused on government contracting, corporate, military and veteran law, and complex litigation.

As a government contract attorney, Mr. Moy handles all aspects of government contract matters to include: solicitation reviews, bid protests before the Government Accountability Office (GAO), the Court of Federal Claims, the Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit, prime/subcontractor disputes, terminations, constructive change claims, equitable adjustments, cost accounting, multiple award schedule contracts, suspension and debarment proceedings, mandatory disclosures, alternative dispute resolution, and other issues under the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) and Contract Disputes Act (CDA). Mr. Moy counsels and assists small businesses in ensuring they meet requirements under the Small Business Administration (SBA) for SBA set asides including service-disabled veteran-owned small businesses, 8(a), and women-owned small businesses. Combined with our expertise in federal employment, Mr. Moy works to ensure compliance with employment and labor-related laws that affect federal contractors in their day to day operations including the Department of Labor Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs (OFCCP), and wage and hour matters, including the Service Contract Act (SCA), the Davis Bacon Act (DBA), and the Davis Bacon and Related Act (DBRA). Further, Mr. Moy's deep understanding of government investigations allows him to advise clients on internal investigations and government investigations

alleging fraud, False Claims Act, the Procurement Integrity Act, the Foreign Corrupt Practices Act (FCPA), and in responding to Department of Justice, congressional, Government Accountability Office (GAO) and Inspector General (IG) subpoenas and investigations.

In his complex litigation role, he represents businesses of all sizes in all matters of litigation, business formation, contract disputes, and mediation.
